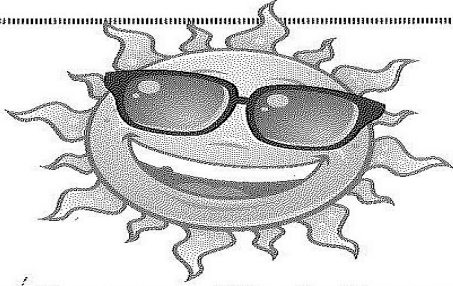

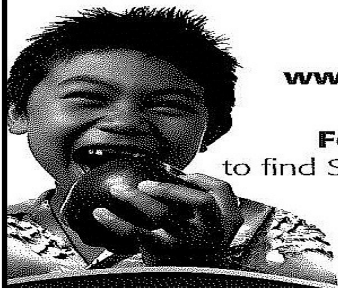
The Summer Meals Program feeds kids and teens 18 years and under. Sites are located at places such as schools, parks and community centers.

Nurse's News

*Please pick up your student's medicines that were stored at school on the last day of school (June 24th). We will not store them over the summer.

*If your student had medications at school or a medical treatment plan, please schedule an appointment EARLY in the summer with your provider so that your student will be ready to go to school with the proper forms filled out and signed by parent/guardian and provider prior to school starting.

*If your student needs to update immunization for a school vaccine requirement, check in with your provider or you can go to the Multicare Immunization Clinic at the South Hill Mall. *Also, Enrolling 6th graders: they must have their TDAP immunization prior to the start of school.
